Individual competition:

The 1st elimination round will start with 16 athletes, where there are less than 16 and more than 8 participants per category, the 1st elimination round will start with the number of athletes of the qualification rounds.

Team competition:

The Team competition starts with 8 teams for the Men and 5 teams for the Women.

Championship-Titles and –Medals will be given for all categories.

Entrance into the courses is allowed for competitors, judges, and field crew only.

The Team Captains, as per the rules, are not allowed to enter the courses, except in case of emergencies and request of the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission.

There are a few targets which can be watched on the blue course along a fenced road, whose access is open to general public and Team Captains.

No mobile telephones or cameras can be taken by the athletes onto the competition field.

Storage of bow cases and spare equipment during the competition will be available either on the competition field or close by in the administration-area.

Results will be available at the competition field and in the evening in the official hotels.

Shooting rules:

Summary:

Red pegs: Compound

Blue pegs: Barebow, Longbow, Instinctive Bow

Individual event:

1 arrow/athlete/target

time: 1 minute

scoring: 1st+2nd Qual.Rounds, 1st+2nd Elim.Rounds: 10X-10-8-5-M

Semi-finals and Finals: 10-8-5-M (10X can be written down, will not be counted)

each athlete in the group shoots by himself or herself

sequence of shooting in the group changes at each target:

1st target: lowest backnumber will start, followed by the next higher back numbers; the last athlete of one target will start shooting first on the next target assigned to the group

Teamevent:

A team consists of 3 athletes (CO+LB and either IB or BB)

each athlete shoots 1 arrow/target = 3 arrows/team

time: 2 minutes

scoring: Elim. Round: 10X-10-8-5-M

Semi-finals and finals: 10-8-5-M (10x can be written down, will not be counted)

Teams shoot one after each other, the Compound athlete in a team starts shooting

The athlete must touch the shooting peg with a portion of his/her body.

The Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission will give you information about scoring and scoringzones in the TC-meeting.

The ranking of the teams for the teamevent will be made automatically by the resultmanagement.

The names of the participants in the Team-event must be given to the resultsmanagement latest Friday 17th of October at 9.00 a.m.

Official Practice and Equipment Inspection:

All shooting-equipment, including spare equipment should be brought to the equipment inspection.

All Team Members should wear their Team Uniform at the Equipment Inspection.

Athletes, officials and staff should have a proper appearance.

For the semi-finals and finals it is required that the name of the athlete participating, is printed on the back of the shirt.

Back numbers for the athletes will be handed out at the Equipment Inspection and must be worn by the athletes as long as they are in the competition, in such a way that the number is easy recognisable.

The Team Captains are requested to check during the equipment inspection again the right spelling of their athletes' names and also check the availability of the correct back numbers. At the equipment inspection also a copy of the scorecard to be used will be shown and explained.

There will be double scoring.

Please ask your athletes to completely fill out and sign the scorecards before handing them in at the end of each round.

The two sets of scorecards must be handed in together and they will not be accepted when they are not completely filled out.

Ceremonies:

The Opening Ceremony will take place in Barcelo Beach Resort, "Dunas" Building, 1st floor in the "Barcelo Auditorium" and will take approx. 1 hrs.

After the speeches and opening there will be a short entertainment followed by a welcome-cocktail.

The athletes will be seated.

Please designate a member of your Team to carry the National Flag.

Teams with own transport should be present at the hall at 18.45 hrs.

The Medal- and Closing Ceremony will take place on Saturday at the competition field, immediately after the last event.

Banquett:

The banquet will be held in the Barcelo Beach Resort, "Dunas" Building in Restaurant "El Estero" and will start at 9 pm.

Beverages are included in the price of 20.00€.

There will be stickers to be put on the accreditation card in order to give access to the banquet and party.

The stickers will be distributed through the Team Captains.

Additional tickets may be acquired at the accreditation office at 20,00€ each.

Afterwards there is a disco in the lobby bar, with free drinks (spirits and softdrinks) for a period of 2 hours, after that for an extra period of one hour there will be drinks at good prices.

Lunches:

Lunches being a part of a Full-Board Hotel arrangement, will be available at the competition area on Thursday, Friday and Saturday from noon onwards. On Wednesday the lunch should be taken in the hotels when Full-Board reservations have been made.

Water:

Water will be handed out before the competition starts. There are a few positions on the competition field where empty water bottles can be exchanged for full ones.

Smoking:

The competition is a smoke free event; smoking is not allowed in the competition areas. Those found smoking where not permitted, will be warned by a written note on the score card and at the next warning they could be disqualified.

Littering:

Please ask your athletes not to litter and either put the litter into the bags on the courses or bring it back to the general area, where also litterbags are available.

Toilets:

Toilets will be available in the general area at the beginning of the courses and then at the far end of each course.

Health – Insects:

There is also due to the season no problem with insects etc. Nevertheless it might be, however, good to take some insect repellent with you.

Doping- and Alcohol testing will be executed.

Athletes being chosen for those tests, should bring their passport and accreditation card with them.

Appeal - Procedure

The Appeal Form is attached to this document. In case of an Intent to Appeal or a Real Appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form attached, must be considered.

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to his deputy. A deposit of Euro 50.- must be paid to the EMAU TD or to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the appeal to be valid.

When the Appeal is accepted by the Jury of Appeal, the money will be returned.

In case of non-acceptance of the appeal the money is not returned.

Article 3.13.2.1:

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, must be expressed in writing and lodged with the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and/or the Jury within 5 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first. The written appeal must be lodged with the Jury within 15 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first, to allow the Jury to come to a decision before the beginning of the next round of the competition.
